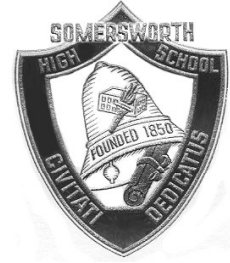

Future Skills & Plans:

- 28 minute block of time on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday when all staff and students silently read material of their choice.
- Students are graded on a Pass/Fail basis reported on report cards and transcripts with the ability to earn 2 credits over a four year time period.
- 28 minute block of time on Wednesday when students learn skills in the areas of personal/social development, academic development, and career development.
- Students discuss topics such as the transition to high school, four-year planning, college and career planning, and interpersonal skills.
